



What to do if you receive a BBS diagnosis

Bardet-Biedl syndrome, or BBS, is a complex disease that affects many systems in the body.

If you are receiving this information, your doctor suspects that you or the person you care for may have BBS. Key signs of BBS include kidney problems, vision loss, early-onset obesity, and intense, hard-to-control hunger.

If left untreated, obesity due to BBS may lead to long-term health problems.
